

## **PPD and CPR**

All clinical educators and graduate clinicians must have an annual tuberculosis skin test (PPD). This test is administered by the Appalachian State University Health Services or other appropriate health organization, and proof of the test is kept on file in the Clinic Office. If a clinical educator or student has a positive test on the PPD, then they must supply the Clinic with proof of a clear chest x-ray or other appropriate treatment. If the Clinic has proof of a clear chest x-ray on file, then the person does not need any further testing unless symptoms appear.

In addition all clinical educators and graduate clinicians must have cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training. CPR is renewed as directed by the administering body.

First aid kits are available in the following locations: Clinic Office (2), Audiology Suite, and PLCC. Each kit contains emergency phone numbers, including Appalachian State University Police, Poison Control, Boone Fire Department, and emergency response agencies; adhesive bandages; gauze pads for covering wounds; cloth tape; antiseptic wipes for cleaning wounds; antiseptic cream; ammonia capsules; and disposable mouth pieces for rescue breathing. In the event that items are used from one of the kits, please notify the Clinic Office so they can be replaced.

An Automated External Defibrillator (AED) is located for easy access in the Communication Disorders Clinic. Only trained personnel should use it.
