

TRAINING

Infection control awareness training for all employees in the Clinic will be conducted prior to their initial assignments to tasks where occupational exposure to bloodborne pathogens and other infectious agents may occur and thereafter on an annual basis. Written documentation of training sessions will be filed with the Office Manager.

All graduate clinicians receive infection control awareness training during their first semester in clinical practicum and thereafter on an annual basis. Infection control awareness training will be scheduled with the University or Clinic infection control training coordinator and will include the following topics:

1. The OSHA Standard for Bloodborne Pathogens
2. Epidemiology and symptomatology of bloodborne diseases
3. Modes of transmission of bloodborne pathogens
4. Hepatitis B Vaccine program
5. Procedures that might cause exposure to infectious substances
6. Products used for infection control
7. Methods to control exposure to blood or other potentially infectious substances
8. Personal protective equipment
9. Postexposure procedures
