

OSHA Infection Control Training

All students in the Communication Disorders Program are required to have annual OSHA Standard Precautions/Infection Control Training. They must have the initial training before beginning clinical practicum. Written documentation of the training sessions will be on file with the Communication Disorders Clinic office. Infection control awareness training is conducted by the Clinic Coordinator and includes the following topics:

1. The OSHA Standard for Blood borne Pathogens
2. Epidemiology and symptomatology of blood borne diseases
3. Modes of transmission of blood borne pathogens
4. Hepatitis B Vaccine program
5. Procedures that might cause exposure to infectious substances
6. Products used for infection control
7. Methods to control exposure to blood or other potentially infectious substances
8. Personal protective equipment
9. Post-exposure procedures
